AND please read ***Dear Mr. Henshaw*** – Beverly Cleary. The main character, Leigh Botts, wrote letters to her teacher. Write three friendly letters to a teacher or other important adults in your life, just as Leigh did. Be sure to follow friendly letter format. The letters are from YOU, so you will sign each letter. Use the [sample letter](#) as a guide and use the included [stationery](#) to write your letters.

AND please read ***Rules***-Cynthia Lord. Write a paragraph identifying and describing a character who acts in a Christ-like manner. Be sure to use examples from the story to support your choice.

Choose at least one of the following books and write a one paragraph summary of the book to catch someone's attention to make them want to read this book:

The Watsons Go to Birmingham, 1963 – Christopher Paul Curtis

Go Big or Go Home – Will Hobbs

There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom – Louis Sachar

***All students will need a student dictionary for the fall. The Merriam Webster paperback dictionary is recommended.**
