

We appreciate your interest in St. John Neumann Regional Catholic School, academic excellence with Catholic vision.

All applicants are required to take an entrance assessment.

Students must be 4 years old to enroll in Pre-K, 5 years old to enroll in kindergarten and 6 years old to enroll in 1st grade, on or before September 1st.

Please complete the following for each child applying to St. John Neumann Regional Catholic School.

- $1. \quad \text{Application Form: Complete one form for each child applying for admissions.}$
 - Visit: SJNRCS.org> Admissions>Apply Now
- 2. Application Fee: a non-refundable \$150 fee must be submitted with each application for grades Prek-8th. This fee is paid at the end of the application on renweb. To pay by check or cash call the admissions office.

All these supplemental documents must be received before the student's application file is complete and considered for admission.

- 3. Birth Certificate
- 4. Baptismal Certificate: Applicable for Catholic Applicants
- 5. Parish Verification: *Applicable for Catholic Applicants*. A signed Parish Verification is required to qualify for the parish subsidized tuition rate. This form is required annually for all SJNRCS Families.
- 6. Student Evaluation Form: Applicable for $1st 8^{th}$ grade applicants. While completing your students' online application you will be prompted to add your student's current teacher's email address for the student evaluation form. Once you complete the online application the teacher will automatically receive a digital evaluation to complete.
- 7. Academic Records: All students applying to grades 1st 8th, please submit a copy of the SJNRCS Records Release Form to your student's current school. SJNRCS requires all report cards and standardized test to be submitted.
- 8. Immunization Form 3231

Acceptance letters are mailed during the first week of April.

Following receipt of an Acceptance Letter, a student is officially enrolled when the following items have been received by the Admissions Office: Student curriculum fees are due upon enrollment in order to secure your students enrollment.

- 1. Signed Parent Contract
- 2. First tuition installment (non-refundable) Due May 1st
- 3. Physical Form due before the first day of attendance
