Read at least two of the following books and write a one paragraph summary of each book to catch someone's attention to make them want to read this book (don't give away too much information) also include an illustration with your summary:

The Watsons Go to Birmingham, 1963 – Christopher Paul Curtis

Go Big or Go Home – Jill Hobbs

There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom – Louis Sachar

Fifth Grade Supply List

For Fifth Grade, we ask that parents purchase the following items and bring them on the first day of school – August 10th.

- 3 packages of loose-leaf **wide-ruled** paper
- 8 two-pocket, three prong, plastic folders (Music, Spanish, Media, and Science can be re-used if still in good condition)
- 4 Composition books – wide rule - Marble (1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 green)
- Continuous supply of #2 pencils
- 2 packs of black or blue erasable pens
- 1 pack of red pens
- 4 glue sticks
- Pair of scissors – small, blunt tip
- 2 Yellow highlighters
- 1 extra-fine and 1 fine black sharpie
- 2 dry-erase markers for classroom use (non-scented)
- Pink eraser
- Small pencil sharpener that collects shavings
- 1 box of thin markers (8 pack)
- 1 box of crayons (16 or 24pack)
- 1 box of colored pencils (12 pack)
- 4 XL or jumbo stretchy book covers
- 1 set of headphones/ear buds to be kept at school
- 1 Soprano Recorder
